



SkiWelt Brixen im Thale is investing EUR 15.5 million in the new Zinsbergbahn




The popular Zinsbergbahn lift, opened in 1987 as Europe's first chairlift with a protective bubble, is being replaced after 32 years of operation, transporting no fewer than 25 million winter sports fans – all accident-free.



The new Zinsbergbahn, a combined cabin- and chairlift, offers ten large gondolas with panoramic views, as well as super-comfortable 8-person seating with bubbles to protect against the weather. It is the first of its kind not only in the SkiWelt Wilder Kaiser – Brixental, but also in the entire Kitzbühel Alps.



WOW! Super-fast and with great views – just 5 minutes up to SkiWelt's "top" viewing point with its new panoramic terrace.





After more than 12,000,000 rides and 25,000 hours of operation, time will be called on 31 March 2019 for the 1983-vintage Fleidingbahn lift! SkiWelt Westendorf has another major project in the pipeline: it has invested EUR 15.5 million in the new 8CLD/B Fleidingbahn, complete with magnificent vistas.



The new Fleidingbahn lift will mean new levels of comfort, service and speed: planned is one of the world's most advanced 8-person chairlifts with comfort suspension, seat heating and bubbles for weather protection. At 2,730 people per hour, carrying capacity will be enormously increased and the new routing will offer skiers a longer piste for yet more fun on the slopes.







Hexenwasser gondola: insanely comfortable, family-friendly & entertaining

Around € 16 million will be invested in a state-of-the-art 10-seater gondola lift in the SkiWelt Söll.





The gondola ride to Hexenwasser Söll will be a real experience in the future - summer and winter - the lift operator Söll has decided to replace the now 30-year-old 8-seater gondola lift by July 2020 with a modern 10-seater gondola. Families and small to very small passengers are particularly well taken care of: for them, the ride on the "Hexenwasser gondola" - as the new, informative name says - will be staged like a comfortable ride on the famous witches' broom and tell entertaining and informative stories.

Each cabin is "bewitched" individually so that the Hexenwasser adventure begins as soon as you enter the gondola. Naturally, all details of the unforgettable "Hexenwasser ride" should not yet be revealed. To tell the least: each of the 72 gondolas in total tunes their guests to the experience on the mountain in terms of design and appearance.





Salvistabahn Itter: So much quality!

The quality offensive in the SkiWelt Hopfgarten-Itter continues and around € 24 million will be invested in the new Salvista gondola including the technology center and reservoir lake.



The Salvista gondola was built in Itter in 1986 - the first two years as a chair lift, and in 1989 a 4-seater gondola lift to the Kraftalm was finally built. In winter 2019/20 this lift will be in operation for the last season and in 2020/21 you will be able to access the Kleine Salve with an ultra-modern 10-seater gondola lift. The valley station of the new cable car is in the same place as the old station, the route to Kraftalm will also be the same. A middle station with boarding and alighting will be built at the Kraftalm, the new lift will be a total of 650 m longer.



The infrastructure in the building of the valley station with sports shop, ski rental and ski depot will be completely renewed. The new Salvista gondola will start operating in time for the 2020/21 winter season.



The attractiveness of the new lift will be increased enormously by the extension of the lift, the creation of new slopes and also by the continuous summer operation in the future.

The Hexenritt starts right at the mountain station and goes to the valley station, **length: 3,8 km**, well secured, with permanent snowmaking machines, opened every day from 8.00 am – 5.00 pm.

Night tobogganing: Wed to Sat, 6.30 pm-9.30 pm. Floodlit until 1.00 am!

Toboggan hire: next to the valley station of Bergbahn Söll



SÖLL - Moon toboggan run

The course goes from the mountain station Hochsöll via Stöcklalm to the valley station, **length: 4 km**, easy with permanent snowmaking and floodlights.

Wed to Sat, 6.30 pm - 9.30 pm it is floodlit until10.30 pm. ONLY open at night for tobogganers. There are four stations, portraying in turn the waxing moon, full

moon, waning moon and new moon.

Toboggan hire: next to the Bergbahn Söll valley station
